Award Amount & Terms:

\$3000 per year will be awarded to selected Nursing Students. The recipient will receive \$1,500 for their first semester. An additional \$1,500 will be awarded for future terms if a 2.75 or higher grade point average is maintained. Renewable gifts are based on scholarship performance

Scholarship Criteria:

- Demonstrate superb work ethic as an employee for at least one year.
 - Must be accepted by a Nursing School. Those already admitted into the Nursing Program are preferred, however anyone willing to work toward program acceptance is encouraged to apply.
 - Student must submit a reference from at least one Nursing Supervisor.
 - Write a 500-word essay on why you need or want a scholarship for a Nursing program.
 - Meet with the scholarship interview team to review your application.

Scholarship Applications will be selected by the Ridgecrest Foundation's Selection Committee; including members of the Board of Trustees, Development Director, Crest Health Center Administrator, and Executive Director.

The following criteria shall be considered by the Scholarship Committee:

- History of being a model employee while working for Ridgecrest Village.
- Evaluation of applicants school activities, community involvement, community and personal activities, and all work experience
- Applicant will submit up to a 500 word essay on why they wish to attend college and their current career goals.
- The applicant's attitude, desire to help seniors and professionalism.
- Applicants shall have at least a 2.75 grade point average on a 4.0 grade scale (or equivalent).
- Students must take enough courses as a nursing student for the purpose of earning credits for a LPN, RN, or Bachelor of Nursing Degree within a reasonable period of time.
